The Ballistic Eyewear with prescription correction in the protective lenses can be a one wrap type low profile eyewear (two lenses covering an eye each with prescription correction in the protective lenses) and should not include an RX carrier solution. ... All Categories of Operational Eyewear must comply with MIL-PRF-32432A or equivalent, covering subject areas such as Ballistic fragmentation protection, Ultraviolet absorption, Haze/resistance to scratching/abrasion, Environment, User survivability and Chemical Resistance. The eyewear must further be assessed as a High Impact Protector in compliance with ANSI/ISEA Z87.1-2010 or equivalent. Categories 1, 2, 3 and 5 must additionally include a dark lens complying with ISO 12312-1:2023 or equivalent, and Category 5 must further comply with STANAG 2029 or equivalent regarding ballistic fragmentation protection.
