The competition documents in the two notices are equivalent, with the exception of the amendments below. • In the previous notice, the SSA-L Annex 1 contained the following formulation in requirement nos. 73 and 74: Requirement no. 73: "The offered system shall be delivered by a tenderer with a licence from the Agency for Building Quality (DiBK)." Requirement no. 74: The offered system shall receive digital applications via the platform Fellestjenester bygg (FtB)." The above mentioned requirements have been removed and replaced with the following requirements in the new announcement: "The tenderer of the system must have the necessary certification from DiBK when the contract is initiated. The certification shall document that the system supports national check-lists, import of application data from FtPB and feedback via FtPB to the application system." • The competition's progress plan has been updated, cf.
