The deadline is counted from the day after the notice has been published. 30 calendar days from the day after the contracting authority has notified the affected tenderers that a contract based on a framework agreement with reopening of competition or a dynamic purchasing system has been entered into, provided that the notification contains a statement of reasons for the decision. 6 months after the contracting authority has entered into a framework agreement, counted from the day after the contracting authority has notified the affected applicants and tenderers, cf. section 2(2) of the Act. 20 calendar days from the day

after the contracting authority has announced its decision, cf. section 185(2) of the Public Procurement Act. No later than at the same time as a complaint is submitted to the Complaints Board for Public Procurement, the complainant must notify the contracting authority in writing that a complaint has been submitted to the Complaints Board for Public Procurement, and whether the complaint has been lodged during the standstill period, cf. section 6(4) of the Act. In cases where the complaint is not submitted during the standstill period, the complainant must also state whether suspension of the procedure is requested, cf. section 12(1) of the Act.
