The plant shall be designed and permitted according to the waste incineration emission law (17th BImSchV). The plant shall be operated via an existing control room. The emissions of the plant shall meet the lowest BREF limits. It is planned to tender in English and with a bespoke contract based on FIDIC Yellow 1999 agreements. There will be only 1 EPC lot. At first, the EPC contractor will be responsible for the engineering needed for the permit application which is submitted by Vattenfall Wärme Berlin AG.
