Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures:

Complaints concerning calls for tenders must be submitted to the Danish Complaints Board for Public Procurement within 45 days of the contracting authority's conclusion of the contract, calculated from the day after the day where the contracting authority publishes a contract notice.

Complaints concerning the pre-qualification must be submitted to the Complaint Board of the Public Procurement with 20 days after the decision of the contracting authority has been submitted to the applicant. The complainant must notify the contracting authority of submission of a complaint to the Complaint Board for Public Procurement in writing along with a notification of whether the complaint has been submitted during the standstill period at the same time as the submission of the complaint to the Complaints Board for Public Procurement. In cases where the complaint has not been submitted in the standstill period, the complainant must also state whether suspensive effect is claimed.
