1) Justification for the choice of the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice in the OJEU in accordance with Directive 2004/18/EC

The works, supplies or services can be provided only by a particular economic operator for the following reason:

Manoeuvre Support Team [MST], part of Land Equipment (LE) of the UK Ministry of Defence (the "MOD"), intends to place an amendment to an existing contract with BAE Systems Global Combat Systems Ltd (the "Contractor") for the design, manufacture, integration and support of modification kits for use of In-Service stowage and recovery equipment on TERRIER vehicles. The estimated cost of this requirement is approximately 390,000 GBP (ex VAT) and will cover a period of up to 5 years inline with the existing Contractor Logistics Support Contract. It is considered that this contract can only be placed with BAE Systems Global Combat Systems using the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice pursuant to Article 28 (1)(e) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16 (1)(a)(ii) (technical reasons) of the Defence and Security Public Contract Regulations 2011) (the "Regulations"). For technical reasons, the requirement can only be placed with BAES Global Combat Systems Ltd, because only they have at their disposal the specific know-how, in-depth knowledge and experience of the TERRIER vehicle, which is necessary to undertake this potential requirement. The Contractor will also need to conduct design work to determine how TERRIER can be modified and how the In-Service equipment can be best integrated by taking into account system specifics. In addition, due to strict safety and interoperability requirements, all modification and integration work required on the TERRIER vehicles would need to be underwritten by BAE Systems Global Combat Systems who are the TERRIER Design Authority (DA). A separate VTN is being published for the procurement, integration and support of up to quantity 13 sets of TERRIER ancillaries containing a hydraulic rock hammer, hydraulic auger drill, hydraulic side shift forks and tarmac ripper in each set.
