The Supplier must take responsibility for all aspects of the implementation, commissioning and on-going maintenance of the service save within the nominated demarcation points. The installation and commissioning of the equipment and the provision of any services shall be carried out in such a manner as to facilitate the normal and routine operation of the CDVEC.
