#### **1) Justification for the choice of the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice in the OJEU in accordance with Directive 2004/18/EC**

All tenders submitted in reply to an open procedure, a restricted procedure or competitive dialogue were irregular or unacceptable. Only those tenderers were included in the negotiations which have satisfied the qualitative selection criteria.

The Air Commodities Team, part of the UK Ministry of Defence, intends to award a Contract to Selex ES for the availability based provision of aircraft avionic and mechanical consumable items/spares for a period of 5 years commencing 1.1.2015. This will also include provision of ad-hoc tasks and a support solution including but not limited to asset and obsolescence management of the consumable items.

It is considered that this contract can be placed using the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice pursuant to Regulation 14(1)(a)(ii) of the Public Contract Regulations 2006. Under Contract Notice [2014/S 073-125442](#) dated 8.4.2014, Selex ES were the only tenderer which submitted a tender but that tender was judged unsuitable. Selex ES were, therefore, invited to negotiate aspects of their tender. The terms of the original contract have not been substantially altered during the negotiated procedure.
