It is considered, for technical reasons, that this contract for a collision warning system should be placed with BAE Systems using the negotiated procedure without prior publication pursuant to Article 31(1)(b) of Directive 2004/18/EC (Regulation 14(1)(a)(iii) of UK Public Contracts Regulations 2006). BAE Systems is the UK Ministry of Defence's nominated Prime Contractor for its Tornado fleet. They provide aircraft safety and technical clearances as part of the Panavia consortium (i.e. The Design Authority for Tornado aircraft). They have the necessary and required skills and support equipment (e.g. software and hardware rigs, specialist tools, Tornado aircrew with current clearances and experience) to enable complex equipment integration to be undertaken onto Tornado aircraft. Additionally, via the UK's ATTAC contract, BAE Systems perform installation and maintenance activities on the UK's Tornado fleet and it is through this contract that the UK will realise technical and cost benefits by having the installation of CWS undertaken primarily via this contract. A Tornado collision warning system solution has already been proven via an assessment phase followed by technical demonstration phase (TDP) in 2009/2010 of a down-selected system supplier. This procurement progresses the TDP to procure that collision warning system solution and design it to be installed onto the UK's fleet of Tornado aircraft.
