LD Pensions is selecting one Investment Manager to provide investment managementservices for Systematic High Yield Bond strategy. Expected size for the mandate is DKK1.750 million, approx. EUR 170 million; however this is strictly indicative due to the inability to determine the precise volume in advance.

The Product/mandate in the Agreement invests in High Yield Bonds including securities that meet benchmark inclusion criteria for either Bloomberg Barclays US High Index or ICE BofA Developed High Yield index. The investment strategy is a long-only, systematic quant driven high yield strategy. The manager will utilize one or more factors to drive allocation in the portfolio. Important strategy aspects are implementation, diversification, and efficient factor capture.

The objective for the mandate is to deliver a minimum benchmark return after fees and transaction costs over a full market cycle.
