— A general description of the contents of the system including an overview of control plans and check-lists that are relevant for this contract.

— A description of when and how the system is implemented in the company and how often the system is updated.

— a description on how the system shall be used for securing the quality of this contract.

Requirement: It is required that the tender has, or will achieve, qualifications for the relevant certification areas in the relevant enterprise classification. The enterprise classification 3 is considered necessary for the main disciplines.

Documentation: Valid certificate showing central certification for the relevant disciplines, or documentation showing that this certification will be achieved, possibly local certification.
