The number of 24 hour periods in the operation is somewhat uncertain, and will i.a. be weather dependant.

The scope of the assignment is somewhat uncertain. The duration of the assignment will be from mobilisation of the work connected to support filling, up to and including demobilisation time after the execution of the support filling. In addition, some work should be expected for preparations and the final report.

The operation for execution of support filling is planned to be carried out in spring/summer 2016, but it is anticipated that the start up will be in May 2016.
