We require a solution that uniquely combines powerful hardware with advanced video analytics software for retrospective viewing of multiple CCTV formats to support video evidence process. The solution will need to provide a searching according to salient attributes facility. The successful supplier(s) needs to provide video search over multiple CCTV sources regardless of camera type, video format, lighting conditions and camera angle; in conjunction with motion detection and a capability that allows for a reviewer to seek out and track down subjects-of-interest, we require the successful provider(s) to have a video analytics platform that provides a case management tool for post-event video analytics accommodating the conversion, curation and ingestion of video data; analysis of that data and the production of reports on the outcome of this analysis.
