The tenders are designed to select the key technical partners who will assist BGH and Fife Council to deliver this ambitious project.

This tender is specifically aimed at the delivery of a hydrogen based energy storage system including a 250 kW PEM electrolyser system, with 50 kg of hydrogen storage, and a 100-150 kW fuel cell for re-converting that hydrogen back to electricity.
