Tax and VAT Requirement: Tenderers must have their tax, payroll tax and VAT payments in order in accordance with the legislation, and tenderers must not have significant arrears.

Norwegian tenderers: After tender submission, the tenderer must give consent for TendSign to obtain and for the contracting authority to receive information about the above via TendSign.

After tenderers have submitted their tenders in TendSign, they will receive a request from Altinn for consent to share the tax information. The consent is valid on an organisation level and is valid for 3 (three) months.

If a tenderer does not give consent, the tenderer must attach a tax and VAT certificate. The certificate must not be older than 6 (six) months from the tender deadline.

Any arrears or other irregularities must be justified. (Tenderers can obtain the electronic tax and VAT certificate itself and immediately receive it by email.)

Foreign tenderers: Tenderers who are not established in Norway can present equivalent documentation issued by the authorities in the country where the tenderer is established. The certificate shall preferably be translated into Norwegian, but it will also be accepted in Swedish, Danish and English.

Credit rating: The economic capacity to fulfil the contract is required. A minimum requirement is that the tenderer is credit-worthy, score A in accordance with Bisnode AS using the service CreditPro, or that the tenderer has the financial capacity to implement the contract, based on the Contracting Authority's assessment given in the submitted documentation from the tenderer.

Newly established companies must have the financial capacity to fulfil the contract.

Experience: The tenderer, or the tenderer's employees are required to have experience from at least 2 equivalent assignments in the last 3 years. Equivalent assignments means the production and delivery of vehicles with similar characteristics, a corresponding order of magnitude and complexity for use within the fire and rescue service.
