1.1 The Police and Crime Commissioner for Nottinghamshire wishes to undertake a compliant EU tender exercise to establish a regional Framework Agreement for the purchase of Medical Services in Custody and Sexual Offence Examination for a period of 4 years (for all Lots) from 1.6.2016. The primary requirement is for Nottinghamshire Police and its specific delivery models are included within lots 1-3.

Other named forces within the East Midlands may choose to use the Framework Agreement in the future and award call-off contracts via mini-competition under lots 4-6. In respect of lots 1-3 the Police and Crime Commissioner for Nottinghamshire intends to award a single call-off contract or 2 call-off contracts via direct award. The Police and Crime Commissioner will

decide upon whether to award a call-off contract for a combination of medical services in custody and sexual offence examination services or separate call-off contracts for these services after receipt of the tenders. The award of the call-off contracts will be made on the basis of the most economically advantageous tender.

For the avoidance of doubt no work is guaranteed under the Framework Agreement.
