The Authority is seeking a provider to integrate an existing application, Bracis (Biological, Radiological and Chemical Information System), onto the BCIP (Bowman and Combat, Information Platform) infrastructure. This Networked BRACIS capability will be an important upgrade to the current Bracis application, used by the UK forces on standalone laptops, which will enhance Warning and Reporting capability while reducing the need for bespoke computer hardware.

The contract will include a service element, up to the out of service date (currently envisaged

as being 2018). There will also be a refresh (currently timed for 2016), but the costs for this are not included in the Networked Bracis project.

VI.3.2. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures: The MOD will incorporate a minimum 10 calendar day standstill period at the point that information on the award of contract is communicated to tenderers. The period allows unsuccessful tenderers to seek further debriefing from the contracting authority before any contract is entered into. Applicants have 2 working days from the notification of the award decision to request additional debriefing and that information has to be provided a minimum of 3 working days before the expiry of the standstill period. If an appeal regarding the contract has not been successfully resolved, the Public Contracts Regulations 2006 (SI 2006 No 5) provide for aggrieved parties who have been harmed or are at risk of harm by a breach of the rules to take action in the High Court, in England and Wales (SSI 2006/1 provides the same provision for the Sheriff's Court or the Court of Session in Scotland). Any such action must be brought promptly (generally within 3 months). Where a contract has not been entered into, the Court may order the setting aside of the award decision or order the authority to amend any document and may award damages. If the contract has been entered into, the Court may only award damages. (The purpose of the standstill period referred to above is to allow parties to apply to the Courts to set aside the award decision before the contract is entered into).
