1) Justification for the choice of the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice in the OJEU in accordance with Directive 2004/18/EC

Extreme urgency brought about by events unforeseeable for the contracting authority and in accordance with the strict conditions stated in the directive.

The UK Ministry of Defence (the Authority) intends to award a 1 year contract with a 1 year option to extend to Revision Military Ltd for the provision of ballistic combat eyewear (the equipment). It is considered that this contract can be placed using the negotiated procedure without prior publication pursuant to Article 28(1)(c) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16(1)(a)(iii) of the Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations 2011 and Article 28(1)(d) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16(1)(a)(iv) of the Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations 2011). The equipment is urgently required for operations in theatre. Further, although the Authority tried to compete a requirement for the equipment, the competition was unsuccessful which has also led to this urgency.. Tendering this requirement under the restricted, or negotiated procedures with publication of a contract notice will result in the failure to deliver the equipment to theatre within the required timescale.
