II.2. Scope of the procurement

II.2.1. Total quantity or scope

The aim of the work is to renew the asphalt cover on roads, streets, pavements, foot and cycle paths that are managed by the contracting authority. The work includes the necessary preparatory work such as resetting of curbs and other necessary and appropriate actions in relation to resurfacing. See the tender documentation and all annexes for further information. The contracting authority will prioritise main roads/feed roads within the ordinary budget volume. In addition there can be option work based on the submitted prices for the main tender and otherwise on the same terms.

The ordinary budget was approx. 30 000 000 NOK on the day the competition notice was published. There is as yet no knowledge about the size of any additional funding for the 2016 asphalt budget.

The exercise of 1 or more options require additional appropriations.

Description of particular conditions: The tenderer is obliged to meet the requirements regarding wages and working conditions in public contracts, dated 8.2.2008.

Oslo municipality requires that Norwegian tenderers, by the start of the contract work, shall be a publicly certified apprenticeship company, cf. the public procurement regulations § 3-11 (3). In addition contractors are required to regularly actually engage apprentices during the contract period. At least one apprentice is required to be engaged for the execution of this concrete assignment.

The contracting authority shall have full authority from the tenderer and sub-suppliers(s) for an unlimited number of times to collect information on the matters specified in the authority, to collect information on tax and duties etc. that are annexed to this contract. The authority is the competition documentation.

The rights and obligations in the authority shall apply from when the authority is signed until 6 months after the contract has been completed.

List and brief description of conditions: Requirement: Tenderers shall be a legally established company.

Documentation Requirements: Norwegian companies: Company Registration Certificate.

Foreign companies: Verification that the company is registered in a trade index or a register of business enterprises as prescribed by the law of the country where the company is established.

Requirement: The Service Provider tax affairs shall be in order in relation to payment of tax and VAT.

Documentation requirement: Tax Certificate for tax and VAT, not older than 6 months.

Foreign tenderers must provide certificates from equivalent authorities to the Norwegian authorities.

— A description and submission of actual parts of the tenderer's quality system, with a statement of when it was last updated.
