The object of this call for tender is to provide consultancy services for the revision of the digital tachograph security framework and draft a technical report, which describes the new security framework of the digital tachograph and the definition of the migration strategy. The revision shall be conducted on the 'Design for Assurance' paradigm for the security aspects. This approach (or paradigm) is extended from the common criteria (available as ISO/IEC 15408) towards the design phases of a product or service and results in the separation of objectives, functional requirements, and detailed requirements.

Once the new digital security framework is established, an additional task will be the definition of the migration strategy from the existing framework to the new framework.

Should an economic operator take part directly (sole tenderer or member of a grouping) or indirectly (subcontractor) in more than 1 tender, the contracting authority reserves the right to examine the tender to assess the possible existence of a conflict of interests and/or collusion between tenderers. Should such a conflict and/or collusion be confirmed, the contracting authority reserves the right to exclude the tenderers involved from participating in this procedure. It is mandatory that joint offers or offers from groupings include a letter of intent from each member of the grouping confirming their participation as described in the submitted bid in case of award of the contract. This applies also to subcontractors with a budget share of 20 % or more. Tenders submitted by groupings of service providers will not be required to adopt a particular legal form prior to the contract being awarded. Should they be awarded the contract they may form a consortium or an association or adopt some other form which would allow them to act as a legal entity or provide the lead member with a power of attorney (to be responsible for the receipt and processing of payments for members of the grouping, for managing the service administration, and for coordination and safety). If the contractor is a grouping or consortium of 2 or more persons, all such persons shall be jointly and severally liable to the Commission for the fulfilment of the terms and conditions of the contract.
