Larne Borough Council proposes to procure a Contractor or Contractors to: provide a service to treat and/or recover residual civic amenity waste ("Contract Waste") delivered by the Council and contractor to a single nominated delivery point so that at least 70 % of such Contract Waste is diverted from landfill by means of recycling and/or recovery. The tenderer's proposal should be supported by sufficient detail in relation to its assumptions on the composition of the Contract Waste and the information on which this is based to allow the Authority to be assured that the Tenderer's proposed diversion level is achievable.
