Services provided by nurses. The service provider will be required to sponsor and support the stoma nurses to offer our current stoma patients the choice of hospital or community services especially with patients now living longer and requiring assessments/review including product appliance use reviews.

The stoma nurses will also be required to provide assessment/support/management to patients with complex stoma/wound that are transferred to the Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust from other hospitals and then discharged back into the community. The stoma nurses will plan to offer a minimum of 2 days per week to community setting supporting both patient and General Practitioners alike through these community clinical sessions.

The Nursing and Admin posts, are based at Russells Hall Hospital, Pensnett Road, Dudley, West Midlands, DY1 2HQ and will provide resource to support to the hospital's requirements for Stoma Care. It is anticipated that the Trust's stoma nurses will be active within the community, typically adding a total of approximately 157 new stoma Clients/Patients per annum. Please note that this figure is not intended to be indicative of the future number of stoma's to occur, but has been provided to illustrate the hospital's total annual number of new stoma Clients /Patients generated historically.
