The contract involves performing inspections, maintenance tasks, tests, repairs, troubleshooting and other work on refrigerating equipment as well as the related measurement and control systems engineering of the field level on ITU premises.

- maintenance, within the time limit or annually, of the ITU's large refrigerating equipment, including correct disposal of the refrigerant,
- leakage testing of the refrigerating equipment and the components thereof, including appropriate keeping of maintenance logs,
- repair (replacement of spare and wear parts included) of the refrigerating equipment and the components thereof in the event of a breakdown, including appropriate keeping of repair logs.

The staff to be assigned must have leak detection/leakage testing qualifications in refrigeration engineering in accordance with DIN EN 473. Proof of expertise is also to be provided for works on refrigerating equipment and air-conditioning units with a minimum filling capacity (CFC and HCFC) of 3 kg.

(c) Proof that the staff assigned by the tenderer are suitably experienced to perform the contract. The staff to be assigned must have at least 3 years' professional experience in the maintenance of refrigerating or similar equipment. CVs outlining the specified professional experience of the proposed staff are to be enclosed.

(d) proof of the candidate's quality-assurance measures in accordance with ISO 9001, a safety management system (e.g. SCC, BS OHSAS 18001), or a description of equivalent quality-assurance or security measures.
