- expansion of the successful community services model for a more community based approach to Mental Health including all levels of voluntary and community sector support,
- historic under investment in mental health when compared to other localities.

A key aim is to ensure that gaps which can develop between primary and secondary care are removed, with support being more available in the communities in which people live. As part of this, the aim of the authority is to work with voluntary services with an enhanced focus in key areas of supporting mental health and wellbeing, which will, in turn, enable people to get the right care, at the right time, in the right place.
