The Early Engagement and Intervention service will operate across Bristol in order to engage with active substance users, including those who are not in contact with ROADS services. As well as alcohol, opiates and crack cocaine, this will include engaging with people who use non-opiates, Novel Psychoactive Substances, and performance and image enhancing drugs. Interventions to improve health and reduce the harms associated with drug and alcohol use will be delivered as well as supporting those furthest away from services to access treatment in a timely manner.
