IV.1.1. Type of procedure

The negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice was used based on Point 11.1(a) of the FR:

‘(a) where no tenders, or no suitable tender, or no request to participate or no suitable request to participate as provided for in point 11.2 have been submitted in response to an open procedure or restricted procedure after that procedure has been completed, provided that the original procurement documents are not substantially altered;’

EUROPOL launched a negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice following three attempts to conclude a contract for Dutch pension rights:

— in 2014, a negotiated procurement procedure with prior publication of a contract notice (ref. D/C55/1423) was published in the Official Journal of the EU (see ref. [2014/S 207-365914](#)).

The procedure was cancelled as no offers were received;

— in 2021, a competitive procedure with negotiation (ref. 2113/C5/N) was published in the Official Journal of the EU (see ref. [2022/S 013-028147](#)). The procedure was cancelled as no offers were received;

— in 2022, an open procurement procedure (ref. 2211/C5/D) was published in the Official Journal of the EU (see ref. [2022/S 069-181804](#)). The procedure was cancelled as no offers were received.

As a result, a contract is awarded based on a negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice.
