The initial project for UCD is for the replacement of furniture as part of UCD's ongoing capital refurbishment programme in the Merville Residences. As part of the contract suppliers will be expected to deliver the order within the last two weeks of August 2012 (specific date to be agreed) and liaise / work with the main contractor to ensure the full delivery, assembly, and fitting of all items in situ in the apartments. Suppliers are also expected to unwrap and remove all associated packaging.

Suppliers will be required to provide a high quality, prompt, efficient and cost effective service to the Third Level Education Institutions at all times.
