Expressions of interest are sought from suppliers able to provide this range of tests on one analytical platform (or platforms collectively no larger than 2.5m x1.5m, which can be managed by one operative) that is able to operate on a random access basis and can be interfaced to the Clinisys Lab Centre computer system.
