Collected and processed data will allow the Commission to assess progress of energy efficiency and other environmental aspects of the selected product groups. Consequently, the data will feed future studies preceding reviews of ecodesign and energy labelling implementing measures.

Furthermore, the data will also be used to support enforcement activities of national authorities. It will also be of interest for other interested parties such as consumers, procurers, retailers, manufacturers, NGO's, etc. To this end, the database will be linked to the 'Energy efficient products facility' that is being concurrently tendered by the EACI.
