The roster should follow, in principle, the following guidelines:

— each pilot shall be involved only in a 2 or 3 days roster; the specific roster will depend on the EASA pilot's availability;

— the pilots are expected to fly about 2 out of 3 sectors as Pilot Flying (PF).

Preferably, the maximum sector block is not beyond 2 hours; up to 33 % of the sectors may be above the 2 hours block time, however the maximum absolute leg block time must not be above 4 hours.
