- The service will afford patients a clinically safe, medically led service that will meet and exceed relevant legal and statutory requirements and Department of Health and local guidance in the delivery of Out of Hours care.
- The Provider will work with local care providers to ensure that pathways are developed which ensure continuity of care across the spectrum of services available to ensure the patient's transfer from unplanned care to planned care is seamless.

- The service will evidence a positive patient experience.
- The patient will be signposted to the most appropriate clinician to meet their clinical need.
