II.1.4. Short description

The contest is for the delivery of a service and maintenance contract for municipal lifts, stairlifts, and lifting platforms, with the aim of ensuring operational reliability through preventive work and correct maintenance.

The contracting authority reserves the right not to use the framework agreement with the tenderer for work carried out by themselves, major, special, or particularly complex work, project related work, work included in turnkey contracts/general contracts, and/or if the contract supplier is not able to fulfil the set requirements/needs, response time, etc.

The contracting authority reserves the right to obtain goods/materials for the work itself.

The contract value is estimated to be above the EEA threshold. The need will vary.

Historically, the contracting authority has procured for NOK 530,000 excluding VAT a year in recent years. The volume can be both higher and lower, and will depend on, amongst other things, the contracting authority's needs, activities, budgetary situation and other framework factors.
