In addition to the system, the object of the procurement includes lamps.

II.2.4. Description of the procurement

The object of the procurement is one (1) digital wide-field imaging and angiography system suitable for especially wide-field imaging of the fundus of the premature newborns and patients in prone position under general anesthesia. System will be used mainly in the surgical departments of the Pediatric Unit of the Eye and Ear Hospital, New Children's Hospital and Women's Hospital.

Wide-field photographs and fluorescein angiography (FAG) are essential in the diagnosis, treatment planning and disease monitoring of retinal diseases of the premature newborns, retinoblastoma and other retinal diseases occurring in children.

In addition to the system, the object of procurement consists of the device consumables (lamps) for which an indefinite contract will be signed with the selected supplier.

The contract is intended to cover the entire life cycle of the system.

The object of the procurement and all the requirements are described in detail in the call for tenders and annexes thereto.

IV.1. Description

IV.1.1. Type of procedure

Award of a contract without prior publication of a call for competition in the Official Journal of the European Union in the cases listed below

Explanation:

Contracting authority i.e. Joint Authority of the Helsinki and Uusimaa Hospital District (hereinafter referred to as "HUS") published a contract notice in 4th of June, 2021 of the procurement of a Wide-field Pediatric Ophthalmic Imaging and Angiography System. By the time limit for receipt of tenders or requests to participate HUS received one (1) tender. The tender HUS received did not meet the minimum requirements governing the suitability of tenderers set in the call for tenders and the tender was not in accordance of the call for tenders.

In accordance of the call for tenders the tenderer must have had at least two (2) corresponding supplies of the devices where the tenderer has supplied the device to a hospital or a company offering health care services within EU/ETA. The tenderer only had one supply of the corresponding object of the procurement within EU.

In addition there were required in the call of tenders that the tenderer undertakes to deliver the device free of charge for the clinical trial use of HUS within twenty-one (21) days upon a separate request by HUS. The tenderer could not deliver the device for clinical trials within the set period of time.

According to the Act on Public Procurement and Concession Contracts section 40, second subsections first paragraph the contracting entity can choose direct procurement if no requests to participate or tenders, or suitable requests to participate or tenders have been received in response to an open or restricted procedure; it shall be a further condition that no essential change has occurred in the terms and conditions of the original call for tenders.

The contracting entity requested a tender from Medicolle AB with the terms and conditions of the original call for tenders 18th of October, 2021. Medicolle AB delivered a tender 4th of November, 2021. The device in the tender HUS received met the minimum requirements set in the original call for tenders.
