The NRA has split the work into two separate Contracts, which will be referred to as Lot 1: Traffic Calming Maintenance Contract — Northern Region and;  
Lot 2: Traffic Calming Maintenance Contract — Southern Region.

The procurement process will comprise of two main stages; qualification and tender. All interested parties must first register their interest on [www.eTenders.gov.ie](http://www.eTenders.gov.ie), download the Information Memorandum and Suitability Assessment Questionnaire and submit a completed questionnaire. The questionnaires will be evaluated and a short-list for Lot 1 and Lot 2 will be prepared. Only those parties that are shortlisted will be invited to tender.
