The traffic on the road network varies from approx. ADT 30 to approx. ADT 7,500 and we anticipate an annual traffic growth of approx. 1,5 %.

The assignment mainly comprises routine operational assignments and minor maintenance assignments for the road network. The Contracting Authority also comprises inspection and registration, planning of activity, contingency in relation to winter operation and general traffic deviation, documentation, reporting to the builder, information to the public and handling of Other assignment necessary for the operation and maintenance of the road network.

Overview and short description of the terms: The tenderer will be a legally established company.

Documentation: company registration certificate from the register of business enterprises. Foreign tenderers must instead submit equivalent certificates determined by the legislation in the state where the tenderer is established.

The contracting authority has, for this competition, made an ESPD form available, which all tenderers must complete and submit together with the tender, cf. § 17-1.

Tenderers shall have good economic and financial capacity to fulfil the contract and shall fulfil the following requirements:

- tenderers must have positive equity,
- average annual turnover of minimum 30 000 000 NOK, for the last 3 fiscal years;
- the tenderer must have an equity ratio of at least 10 %.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

Documentation requirement:

- 1) The tenderer's Annual Financial Statement, the Board's Annual Report and Auditor's Report for the last 3 years and newer information (quarterly reports) of significance to the tenderer's fiscal figures. The form in chapter E2 point 4 shall be completed;
- 2) If relevant; a brief account on information on economic conditions or losses that are not documented other places, and that must be documented in accordance to the Norwegian and /or international accounting standards;
- 3) If relevant; an overview of any newly implemented, ongoing or pending tax or public reviews of the tenderer's business.

If the tenderer has justifiable cause to not present the documentation requested by the Contracting Authority, he can document his economic and financial capacity to submit any other

Document of relevance to the company's fiscal figures/economy and that the Contracting Authority considers suitable. The tenderer must give grounds for why he cannot present the documentation requested by the Contracting Authority.

Relevant experience:

1) The main disciplines included in the assignment include: operation and maintenance of roads;

2) The following sub-assignments are of significant importance for the contract work:

- winter operations,
- clearing traffic areas/traffic objects,
- construction notification and traffic management.

Builder's experience:

The Norwegian Public Roads Administration and other builders' experiences with the tenderer will be assessed.

The tenderer is required to present references for relevant contracts that he himself has implemented in a satisfactory manner.

Conditions which will be evaluated are related to, a.:

- documentation of completed quality,
- fulfilment of contracts,
- compliance with provisions and procedures for HSE,
- compliance with provisions for wages and working conditions,
- observance of deadlines,
- follow up during the warranty/claims period,
- use of apprentices.

SHA system:

The tenderer must have a system that demonstrates working pro actively to ensure the safety, health and work environment (SHA), with relevance for equivalent works included in this contest. The system will be subject to periodic review.

Accident frequency (H1-value)

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers and their central contract facilitators should have an average H1 value lower than 10 for the last 3 years.

If the H1 value is higher than ten, an account must be given of the developing trend of the H1 value and any F value, that will express

The severity of any high H1 value.
