The service will be delivered and based in the London Borough of Waltham Forest and managed locally.

The aim of the procurement is to procure a service that provides a high quality and clinically safe integrated wheelchair service, including the assessment and provision of equipment, aftercare, maintenance and support for adults and children who have a physical/cognitive and /or degenerative long term condition which limits mobility. This may also include people who require end of life care.
