The breakdown per Council is approximately 19 000 tonnes for Sefton, 13 500 tonnes for Wirral, 7 000 tonnes for St. Helens and 7 000 tonnes for Knowsley. The tonnage values represented in this document are for evaluation purposes only and the tonnage figures cannot be guaranteed. The 4 Authorities will however, offer contract exclusivity for Green Waste arising for the duration of the contract.

The contract duration will be for a 5-year core period commencing 1.11.2019, and there will be 2 x 12-month extension options available.
