The Secretary of State for Defence (the Authority), acting through the Medical Delivery Team, proposes to award a contract to David Brett Services Ltd ('the Contractor') for the supply of 15 Ruggedised Blood and Plasma Storage units. It is considered that this contract can be placed using the negotiated procedure without prior publication of a contract notice pursuant to Article 31(1)(b) of Directive 2004/18/EC (Regulation 14(1)(a) (iii) of the UK Public Contracts Regulations 2006) for technical reasons. This is because the Contractor is the current supplier of Ruggedised Blood and Plasma Storage Units (which have been modified for use in remote environments and to withstand extreme temperatures) and is therefore the only supplier able to supply the units to the necessary specification to comply with blood storage regulations within the timescales required by the Authority in order to support operations against the Ebola virus in Sierra Leone.
