Lot title: Part 1: Manually-operated turning lathes

1) Short description

During summer 2015, shall the Sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 Industrial engineering, relocate to a new workshop building 4 at Kristiansund sixth forms of comprehensive school. The new building 4 is meant to be used by the first level of the Sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 Industrial engineering, the Sixth forms of comprehensive school 1 Technical and General subjects, the Sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 Technical and General subjects, as well as the Sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 automation.

In accordance with the school use plan, an additional class at the sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 Industrial engineering, shall be established for the next school year 2015/16

In the plans for the new building 4, it is planned and drew in 7 turning lathes. The Contracting Authority requests tenders for these turning lathes.

The new building 4 has a 400 volt electricity system, which the tenderers must take into considerations in connection with preparation of their tenders.

The 7 new turning lathes must be delivered within July 2015, at the latest, so that the school can start the school year 2015/2016 for all of the classes that shall use the new building 4.

Lot title: Part 2: A CNC-operated cutting machine

1) Short description

Kristiansund sixth forms of comprehensive school will require a CNC-operated cutting machine with a cutting board. The cutting machine shall be used for training in the subject production at the sixth forms of comprehensive school 1 engineering and industrial production and technical and general subjects and the sixth forms of comprehensive school 2 technical and general subjects and Industrial engineering as well as mechanical disciplines at the sixth forms of

comprehensive school 2 and the sixth forms of comprehensive school 3 automation, in accordance with the subject curriculum.

The training is directed toward the local workshop industry as well as the shipbuilding industry and offshore-based industry in the region. Training, use and management of the cutting board are a large and important part of the works in these industrial companies.

The machine will be 1 of few CNC-operated machines at the school and will be in daily operations for a large number of students in the mentioned education programme.
