I ett samarbetsprojekt mellan åtta kommuner i Västmanlands län och en kommun i Uppsala län ska 27 nedlagda deponier genomgå en miljöteknisk markundersökning. Vafab Miljö AB har fått kommunernas uppdrag att samordna en upphandling av en tjänst som innebär undersökningar av mark, sediment och/eller grund- och ytvatten, ge förslag på riskklassificering samt i förekommande fall ge förslag på behov av ytterligare åtgärder inklusive kostnadsuppskattning. Dessa miljötekniska undersökningar är en fortsättning på en MIFO fas 1 inventering som gjordes 2011 av totalt 96 deponier i Västmanlands län. Resultatet av inventeringen visade att det fanns ett behov av att undersöka vissa objekt ytterligare för att närmare för att utvärdera föroreningsnivåer, spridningsrisker och risk för människor och miljö. Syftet med uppdraget är att genomföra miljötekniska markundersökningar på totalt 27 deponier i nio kommuner i VafabMiljö-regionen. Syftet med dessa undersökningar är att:

- Ta fram underlag för att bättre förstå föroreningssituationen på varje objekt.
- Göra en fördjupad riskbedömning inklusive riskklassificering för varje objekt.
- Ta fram förslag på vidare åtgärder eller behov av ytterligare undersökningar där detta är påkallat.
