- resurfacing of the existing runway 07-25 (including tie-ins to adjacent operating surfaces) by asphalt inlay,
- the slurry sealing of the runway 07-25 shoulders,
- the replacement of runway 07-25 drainage gully covers,
- the reinstatement of affected airfield line markings,
- provision of a fillet between runway 07-25 and the cross runway to ease the turn for aircraft using the cross runway as a taxiway,
- provision of a new fire access road and associated markings,
- the rehabilitation of runway 07-25 associated Aeronautical Ground Lighting (AGL) and minor upgrading of AGL systems.
