Hutchison Ports (UK) Ltd operates 3 Ports within the UK: The Port of Felixstowe, Harwich International Port and London Thamesport and has a range of electric motors (AC and DC) (9.5 to 560 kW) and alternators which require servicing, repair and maintenance services including but not limited to test readings, basic overhauls, rewinds, mechanical repairs, modifications, load testing and vacuum pressure impregnation.

The Contractor will be required to provide transport for both collection from and delivery to the Ports.

The Contractor will carry out the services at it's own premises or on occasion (for minor maintenance or repairs) within a designated working area at the Port. The Contractor must be able to provide a 24/7/365 call-out service, with access to workshop facilities. It is essential that the geographical location of the Contractor's workshop facility is within a 100 mile radius and a maximum journey time by road of 2 hours from the Port of Felixstowe (Postcode: IP11 3SY). This is to enable the Ports engineers to arrange site visits to routinely inspect works being undertaken, ensure response times are kept to a minimum and so that repair issues can be discussed and site visits arranged to discuss solutions.
