The objective of the procurement is to cover VAV's extended need for engineering design competence within water and sewage. The engineering design competence is a prerequisite for VAV being able to carry out its planned projects. The need for engineering design competence also includes a need for competence within technical drawing/CAD.

Sub tenders can be submitted in this competition. Three categories of consultants shall be hired: There can be several contracts for each category, up to a stated amount of manlabour years.

The award will be based on an evaluation of the offered consultants separately in the categories that they are offered in. This means that each CV and offered consultant will be seen as 1 tender, and a price form shall be filled in and 1 competence form (cf. annex 4) per offered consultant.

Up to 2 parallel tenders can be submitted for each of the 3 categories and in different availability percentages for engineering design competence. Further details are given in the requirement specifications.

The offered consultant can only be offered for 1 of the 3 categories.
