Extreme urgency brought about by events unforeseeable for the contracting authority and in accordance with the strict conditions stated in the directive.

It is considered that this contract can be placed using the negotiated procedure without prior publication in accordance with Article 28(1)(c) of Directive 2009/81/EC; pursuant to Regulation 16(1)(a)(iii) of the Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations 2011 (DSPCR 2011).

This is because the supply of ECBA Body Armour Plates to theatre as an interim measure in support of Op Herrick 19, and contingent operations has become urgent. Tendering this requirement under the restricted or negotiated procedures with publication of a contract notice as referred to in Regulations 17 and 18 of DSPCR 2011 will result in the failure to deliver the equipment to theatre within the required timescale.
