The contracting authority's goal is to facilitate increased collaboration within the contract, including measures like the establishment of permanent routes and coordinated patient transport services across municipality borders and tender areas, for example, by the use of vehicles from other contract suppliers, which, instead of being on stand-by, can be used for transport assignments in and starting in Malvik Municipality.

The contracting authority also reserves the right to outsource new transport systems. The total value of the outsourcing and separate transport assignments must not exceed 10 % of the estimated annual contract value.
