The following NHS Trusts require collection, transportation and disposal of clinical waste throughout the Buckinghamshire and Oxford area:

- Heatherwood and Wexham Park NHS Foundation Trust.
- Oxford University Hospitals NHS Trust.
- Buckinghamshire Healthcare NHS Trust.
- Milton Keynes Hospital NHS Foundation Trust.

The Contractor(s) will be required to uplift clinical waste from Trust premises at scheduled frequencies and also as and when required. All clinical waste uplifted must be transported, off-loaded in a secure area as defined by the appropriate legislation or the terms of the Contractor's Licence and must be disposed of in a suitable manner in accordance with the DOH Safe

Management of Healthcare Waste Guidance.(Reference 7658:1.8) In addition the Contractor (s) will be required to carry out their activity in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, Controlled Waste Regulations (1992), the Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Regulations 1991, Safe Disposal of Clinical Waste (1992), Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road Regulations (1996), Hazardous Waste Regulations (2005) and any other relevant and applicable legislation, Code of Practise or Guidance.

The attached summary provides details of the Acute Hospitals and Community Health premises included in this procurement including the scope and volume of the service required. Further requirements will be provided at the Invitation to Tender Stage (ITT).

The contract will be let in two 'lots':

— Lot 1- Acute Hospitals covering all the Trusts listed above.

— Lot 2- Community Health premises covering Buckinghamshire Healthcare NHS Trust and Milton Keynes Hospital NHS Foundation Trust [Who provide a service to the Community Health Provider currently hosted by Bedford Hospital NHS Trust].

The contract will be awarded to one bidder per lot and therefore applicants should ensure that they have the capacity and experience to fulfil the contract.

The contract term will be for a minimum period of five years with an extension of up to two years by agreement. At the ITT stage the possibility of a longer contract period will be explored (Minimum period of eight years with the an extension of up to two years by agreement).

The Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006 (TUPE) will apply to this procurement.

The contract opportunity has been advertised in the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU). The NHS Standard Conditions of Contract for Services and additional Supplementary Conditions of Contract will apply to this contract. It is envisaged that each participating NHS Trust will sign a separate contract for their individual requirements with the successful bidder (s).
