Initially the contract covers provision of the service to the final (third) tranche of Project Subhan 10 over the period 1.3.2012 to 30.8.2012. Additionally, the contract contains an option to provide the full annual requirement of 3 tranches for Project Subhan 11 (which has a planned delivery window of 1.6.2012 to 30.8.2013). If required, this option will be exercised at

the Authority's sole discretion.
