Explanation:

Vehicle Support Team, in service Platforms, part of the UK Ministry of Defence ("MoD"), intends to award a Contract to BAE Systems Global Combat Systems Limited "BAE Land UK" to harvest 4 Terrier vehicles for serviceable line replacement units. The contract will be for 6 months with a contract value of 385 000 GBP plus VAT.

It is considered that this Contract can be placed using the Negotiated Procedure Without Prior Publication of a Contract Notice pursuant to Article 28(1)(e) of Directive 2009/81/EC [Regulation 16(1)(a)(ii) of the UK Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations 2011] for technical reasons. This is because BAE Land UK are the Design Organisation (DO) for the Terrier and are the only organisation with the extensive in-depth knowledge of the platform and access to original underlying technical knowledge. It is the only organisation with the necessary experience of the repair parameters to sentence the Line Replacement Units and is the only organisation to hold the necessary repair specification of the equipment to ensure the parts are certified for the safe operation of the Terrier platform. The harvested parts must meet the required "Grade A2 standard" to ensure they are ready to be re-used safely. Without this knowledge and experience it would be technically impracticable for another economic operator to safely fulfil the requirement.
