University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust (incorporating the QEHB Queen Elizabeth Hospital) has a requirement for a lung function testing and sleep department respiratory system, requiring replacement from the 2015-16 capital programme.

The requirement is for 6 fully integrated systems and 2 additional portable systems, with consumables.

The Lung Function and Sleep department is an essential physiological scientific diagnostic service for QEHB. This proposal affects all patients attending QEHB requiring any lung function testing (out-patients, in-patients, pre-transplant, pre-operative and monitoring) as it

replaces a current suite of equipment that was procured 7 years ago, and requires replacing. By having 6 full testing systems will mean the Trust can increase the number of patients tested and reduce waiting times for more complex tests.
