The contract must be sufficiently staffed and the tenderer must have the capacity and qualifications to deal with the described work and complexity in the contract, as well as unforeseen circumstances.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

Documentation that the requirements listed in the building application regulations, chapter 11 are met with a certificate for relevant and valid central certification, or other documentation verifying that the tenderer meets the requirements.

A description of the tenderer's (and any sub-supplier's) up to five, but not less than three, most relevant assignments for each of the listed works in the requirement, which the tenderer has carried out or is carrying out in the last five years calculated from the tender deadline.

An account of sufficient capacity/resources, organisation plan, and a short description of the organisation for the contract, CVs for the offered site manager and project manager.
